#### Hagar: Genesis 16 & 21

Hagar was caught in a mess that was not her choice. Her mistress, Sarah, who had not had any children, concocted a plan to do things her own way and provide her husband an heir through her servant, Hagar. As a servant, Hagar had no choice in the matter. Abraham listened to Sarah. Hagar became a wife to Abraham, and soon she became pregnant. Sarah dealt harshly with Hagar, and we see a pregnant and likely very scared Hagar flee into the wilderness. It is in the wilderness that Hagar is met by the angel of the Lord. He encourages her to return to Abraham and Sarah but makes her a promise. Abraham had been promised a great nation, and now we see this servant girl promised that her offspring would be multiplied.

The Lord tells her to name her son Ishmael because God has heard her. Hagar then calls the Lord a unique name, El Roi - meaning the God who sees. Hagar recognized that the Lord saw her right where she was. He saw the mess that she was in, and He cared enough to come to her.

Perhaps your life has not turned out the way that you had planned either. Perhaps the circumstances of life, whether caused by yourself or someone else, have left you feeling desperate and alone. There is hope. Our God is the God who sees. He hears your burdens, and He sees you right where you are. He is good, and He is faithful. He will provide water in the wilderness and hope for your soul.
