

Covenant	Administration Of Grace	How It Builds/Complements The Previous
Noahic	Promise never to destroy the world by flood	God's faithfulness in judgment and mercy is shown; all humanity shares in the consequences of sin and hope of salvation
Abrahamic	Promise of land, descendants, and blessing	God's grace begins to focus on a particular people; the promised blessing points forward to the ultimate blessing in Christ
Mosaic	Law given to Israel	Shows humans' inability to achieve righteousness by works; points forward to the need for a Savior
Davidic	Promise of an eternal kingdom	Prepares for Christ's eternal reign; emphasizes God's faithfulness to fulfill promises
New Covenant (Jeremiah 31, fulfilled in Christ)	Christ's work of salvation	Culminates all previous covenants; perfect obedience of Christ fulfills the Covenant of Works, and His sacrifice completes the Covenant of Grace
